Supervision requirement:

Direct

The supervisor must be present at the application site. They must provide detailed instructions to the worker, be aware of the worker's actions and able to intervene or correct the worker's actions in a timely manner if required.

Appropriate

Appropriate provision of an effective level of supervision (may range from direct to indirect) depending on the skills and experience of the applicator and the complexity of the task.

Indirect

The supervisor should be contactable and available to assist if required. Guidance (written or verbal) should be specific to the task, that is, the product, equipment used, and application time and place and should include a requirement for the worker to undertake an on-site risk assessment prior to starting the task.

This decision tree does not apply. There are greater requirements for training and supervision.

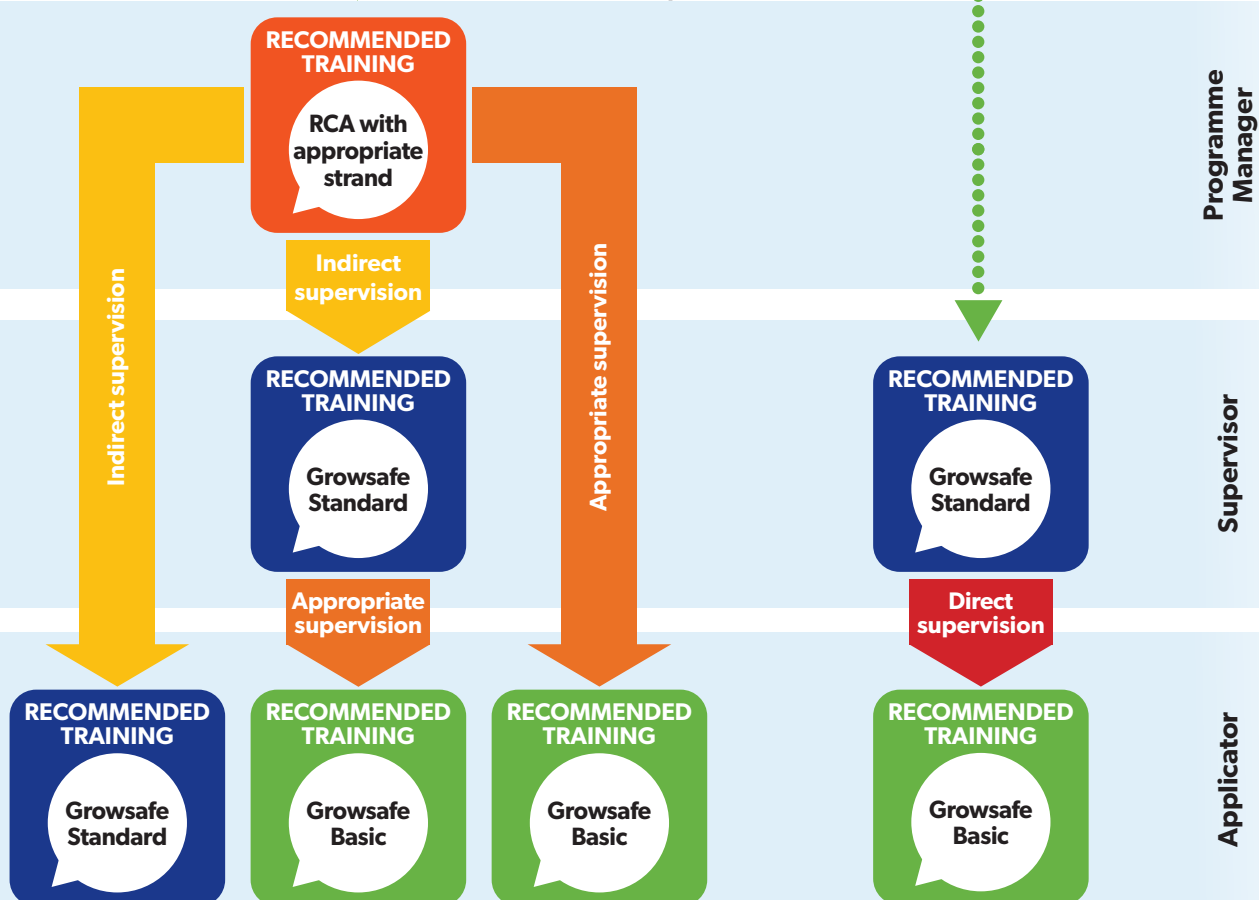
